Pile Driving for the New Bridge Planned to Start Friday, Nov. 17

What's Happening?

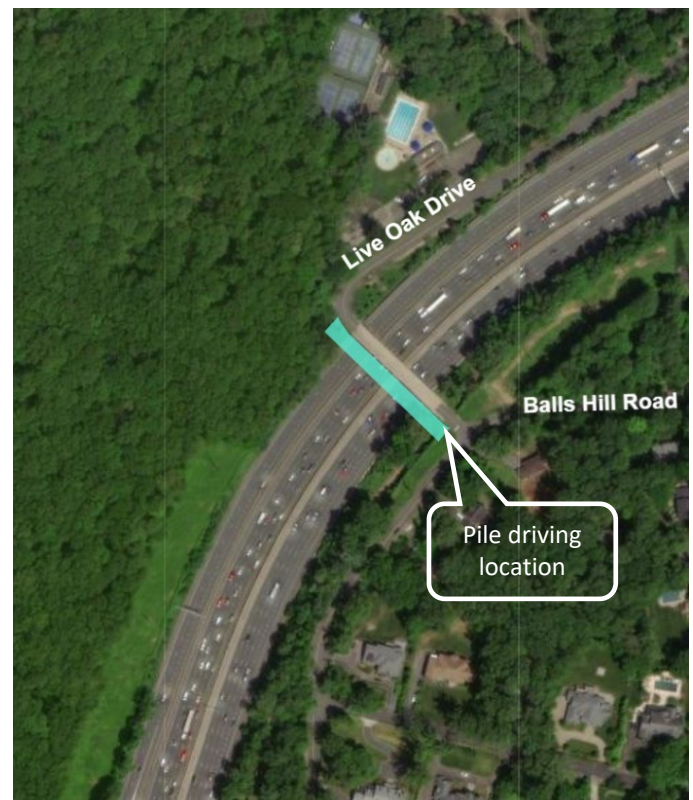
Daytime pile driving for the eastern abutment of the new Live Oak Drive bridge is planned to start Friday, Nov. 17 and continue through Wednesday, Nov. 22.

What Should Neighbors Expect?


Pile driving involves hammering steel piles into the ground to support the foundation of the future bridge. When active, neighbors will hear hammer strikes every few seconds. Pile driving will occur only during daytime hours.

What's Happening Next?


Subsequent work includes completing the abutments and relocating utility lines. Next, bridge beams will be lifted into place over the Beltway, an activity that must be performed during nighttime hours because the highway below must be closed to traffic for safety reasons. The deck and remaining elements of the bridge will then be constructed.
