



495 NEXT Project Lane Closures and Traffic Changes

For December 18 - December 22, 2022

The following construction-related lane closures and traffic changes are planned to occur in the I-495 Express Lanes Northern Extension (495 NEXT) project corridor. Travelers should expect potential delays when traveling in this area, and are encouraged to visit 511virginia.org for current information on travel conditions and work zones in Virginia. All construction-related work and closures are subject to change based on weather and other factors.

Upcoming Highlights

- Nighttime multi-lane closures on I-495 North and South.
- Daytime single lane closures on I-495 North and South.
- Daytime and nighttime mobile lane closures on I-495 North and South
- Daytime and nighttime single lane closures on Dulles Toll Road.
- Nighttime single lane closures on Dulles Access Road.

Lane Closures

I-495 (CAPITAL BELTWAY)

I-495 North and South

Sunday, December 18, through Wednesday, December 21, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.
Triple right lane closures on southbound I-495 between George Washington Memorial Parkway and Old Dominion Drive for roadway joint repairs and cell tower removal at the Old Dominion Drive bridge.

Motorists coming from George Washington Memorial Parkway heading for southbound I-495 will be directed to access the Beltway by staying right and taking the ramp up to Georgetown Pike, proceeding straight through the traffic light, and taking the ramp back down where traffic will then be able to merge onto the Beltway. Sunday, December 18, through Wednesday, December 21, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.
Double right lane closures on northbound I-495 from the Lewinsville Road bridge to the Georgetown Pike bridge for setting temporary barrier for noise wall work.

Sunday, December 18, through Wednesday, December 21, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. and Monday, December 19, through Thursday, December 22, 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Mobile lane closures on north- and southbound I-495 as needed for traffic maintenance work.

Monday, December 19, through Thursday, December 22, 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.
Single left lane closures on north- and southbound I-495 between the Old Dominion Drive bridge and the Live Oak Drive bridge for work on the two bridges.

DULLES CORRIDOR INTERCHANGE

Dulles Toll Road

Sunday, December 18, through Wednesday, December 21, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.
Single left lane closures on westbound Dulles Toll Road between Route 123 and the I-495 interchange for setting temporary barrier.

Monday, December 19, through Thursday, December 22, 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.
The onramp from Dulles Toll Road to northbound I-495 (exit 18) will be narrowed (no lane closures) for vehicle access to the construction yard.

Monday, December 19, through Thursday, December 22, 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.
Single left lane closure on westbound Dulles Toll Road between Route 123 and the I-495 interchange for preparation for bridge work. The right shoulder of the westbound Dulles Access Road will also be closed for this work.

Dulles Access Road

Sunday, December 18, through Wednesday, December 21, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.
Alternating left and right lane closures on eastbound Dulles Access Road between Route 123 and the I-495 interchange for setting temporary barrier.

Traffic Changes

I-495 North Exit to Dulles Toll Road

Reminder: Motorists traveling on northbound I-495 heading for westbound Dulles Toll Road must take a new, earlier exit. The new exit ramp is located about one-third of a mile ahead of the old, closed Exit 45. To facilitate this new traffic pattern, I-495 has been reduced from four to three lanes for approximately one-half mile near the Dulles Corridor interchange. George Washington Memorial Parkway West at I-495

Reminder: The ramp from westbound George Washington Memorial Parkway to southbound I-495 (Capital Beltway) was reduced from two lanes to one lane to make room for a construction vehicle haul route that will be separated from traffic by a physical barrier. This traffic change will be in effect throughout construction on the 495 NEXT project. [Learn more about the traffic change here.](#)

I-495 Interchange Ramps

Several interchange ramps in the project corridor have been or will be narrowed to allow for daytime and nighttime shoulder strengthening work. The ramps will be narrowed through fall.

Ramps that are or will be narrowed include:

- Ramp from westbound George Washington Memorial Parkway to I-495 South
- Ramp from I-495 North to eastbound George Washington Memorial Parkway
- Ramp from I-495 North to Georgetown Pike
- Ramp from westbound Dulles Toll Road to I-495 North

Project Background

The I-495 Express Lanes Northern Extension (495 NEXT) project will extend the existing 495 Express Lanes north by two-and-a-half miles from the Dulles Corridor

interchange to the George Washington Memorial Parkway interchange in the vicinity of the American Legion Bridge. The project will provide new and improved connections at the Dulles Corridor and George Washington Memorial Parkway.

Other project benefits include four miles of new bicycle and pedestrian connections including a shared-use path parallel to I-495 from Lewinsville Road to near Live Oak Drive, replacement or rehabilitation of seven bridges with pedestrian accommodations, replacement of nine existing noise walls and construction of a new noise wall, environmental improvements introducing stormwater management facilities and funding of restoration at Scotts Run stream, and dedicated funding to support transit improvements in the corridor including new bus service over the American Legion Bridge.

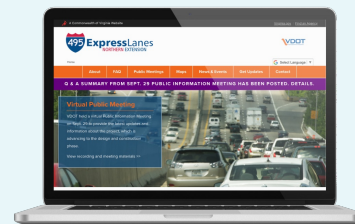
495 NEXT is a public-private partnership project between the Commonwealth of Virginia and Transurban, operator of the existing 495 Express Lanes. Lane Construction is the design-build contractor for the project. The new extended lanes are scheduled to open in 2025.
